DEAN OF NURSING

The Dean of Nursing is responsible for the overall oversight of the nursing program quality, curriculum development, and maintaining a high-quality faculty. The Dean of Nursing provides leadership and counsel to faculty and students, monitors trends in nursing education, participates in research, ensures adherence to federal, state, and College regulations, maintains accreditation standards, and establishes clinical partnerships.

Major Responsibilities

The Dean of Nursing exercises broad responsibilities for leadership and nursing program management. In addition, the Dean will be responsible for the following:

- Responsible for promoting and maintaining compliance with state and national accreditation standards;
- Analyzing, communicating, and responding to emerging global, national, and regional trends in healthcare and nursing education;
- Strengthening and building connections and partnerships with internal and external stakeholders;
- Responsible for the nursing curriculum, teaching strategies, and the developmental use of assessment of student learning;
- Fostering a high-quality student experience and student success;
- Recruiting, retaining, supporting, and mentoring faculty who will continue the College's progress in its mission. This includes making teaching, simulation, skills lab, and clinical faculty assignments.
- Advocating for the College and increasing its visibility and reputation regionally and nationally;
- Promoting professional development opportunities;
- Providing academic leadership in the strategic planning activities, which formulate, implement and evaluate goals and objectives for the College;
- Responsible for the nursing program information for the preparation of the annual operating budget;
- Performs other duties as required for the success of the nursing program.

Qualifications

- An experienced nursing leader with a Ph.D., doctorate in nursing, EdD, or similar earned doctorate is preferred.
- A Master of Science degree in Nursing from an accredited university and/or program is required.
- Eligible for licensure as a registered nurse in the State of Illinois.
- Experience in academic and clinical achievement; two years in clinical nursing practice and two years nursing education instructor.
- A strong vision and experience in promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion.
- Involvement in innovative curriculum design.
- Support the use of emerging technologies and simulations to enhance student learning.
- Demonstrated knowledge and involvement with accreditation processes of nursing programs.
